- We'll arrange smooth connecting travel (bus or train) from Pune to Mumbai so you reach Bandra Terminus on time for the 00:20 departure.

If you're traveling from any other city in India:

- Train tickets will be booked directly from your home city to Haridwar based on your preferred dates, ensuring you sync perfectly with the main group.

Day 4: The Scenic Journey to Barkot

After a delicious breakfast and hotel check-out, we begin our beautiful drive toward the peaceful hill town of Barkot. It is a day dedicated to enjoying the natural beauty of the region as we head toward the gateway of your Yamunotri Yatra. Day 5: The Holy Yatra to Yamunotri Dham

Reaching the temple is a powerful experience, as it marks the sacred origin of the Yamuna River near the magnificent Champasar Glacier. After seeking blessings at the shrine and soaking in the divine energy of this high-altitude sanctuary, you will return to Hotel, concluding a deeply fulfilling day of your spiritual journey.

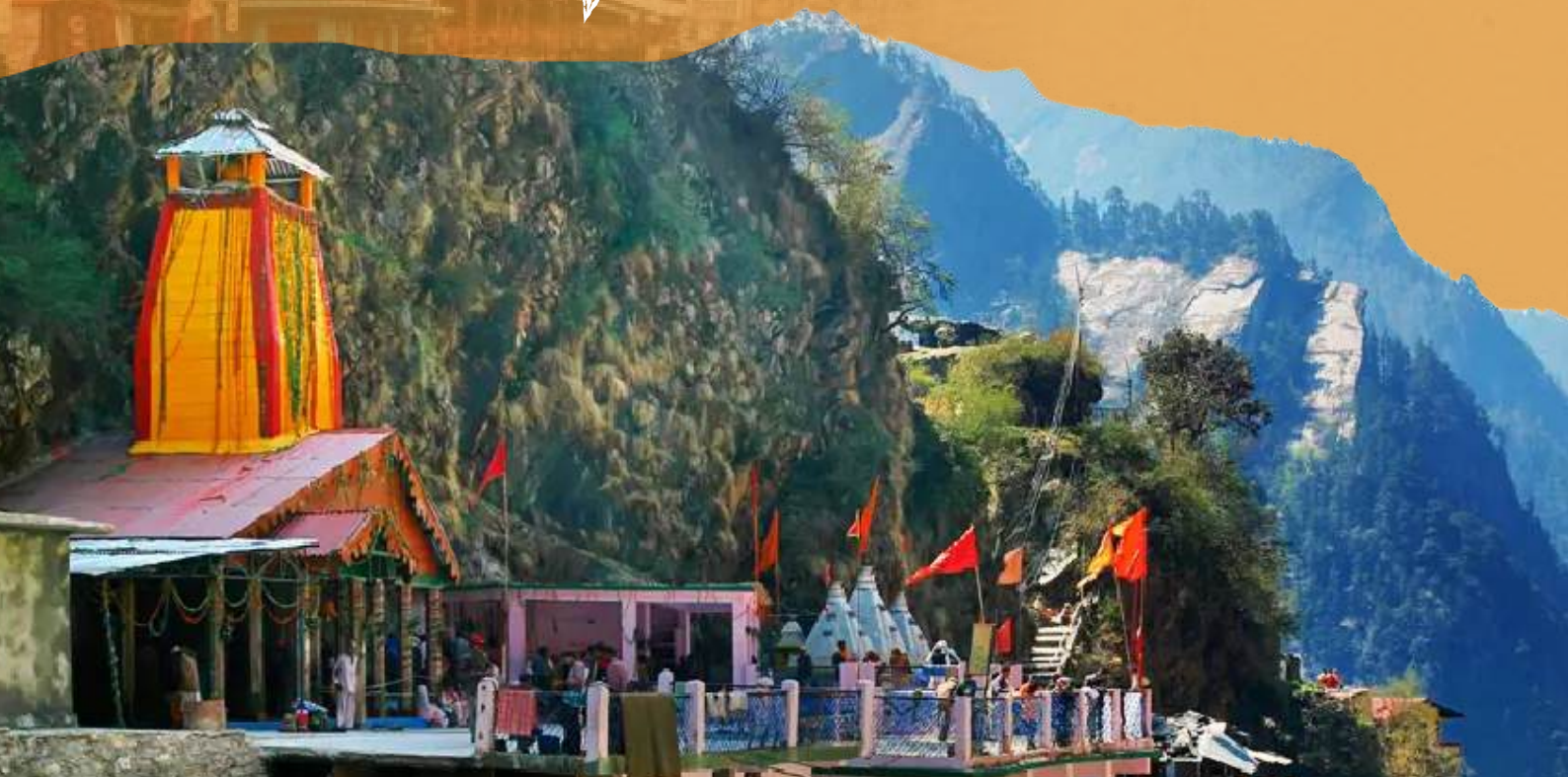

Day 6: Journey to the Kashi of the North

After a hearty breakfast and hotel check-out, we begin a scenic drive through the Garhwal Himalayas toward the holy town of Uttarkashi. After seeking blessings at the shrine and soaking in the powerful spiritual energy of the riverbank, we will drive back to Uttarkashi. The day concludes with a delicious dinner and a restful overnight stay, leaving you deeply reflected by the magic of the second Dham.

Day 8: Scenic Drive to the Gateway of Kedarnath

After an early breakfast and hotel check-out, we begin a beautiful journey toward Phata, the gateway to Kedarnath. This long, scenic drive takes you through winding mountain roads and dense forests, offering incredible views of the Mandakini River as it flows directly from the Kedarnath Glacier. We'll make refreshing stops at the best viewpoints so you can soak in the Himalayan serenity and capture perfect memories. By evening, we'll arrive in Phata—a town steeped in mythology and home to its own ancient Vishwanath Temple. After checking in and relaxing, you'll have a peaceful night to recharge before your divine trek to Kedarnath begins.

Day 9: The Divine Trek to Kedarnath

After an early breakfast, we head from Sonprayag to Gourikund to begin your much-awaited Yatra to Kedarnath Dham. You can choose to trek or take a pony for the scenic 10–12 hour journey, passing through famous stop points like Jungle Chatti, Bheem Bali, and Badi Lincholi. We aim to reach the temple by 5:30 PM, giving you enough time to settle in before witnessing the powerful and soul-stirring Evening Aarti at 6:30 PM. After seeking blessings at the shrine, you can enjoy a warm dinner and head to your hotel for a well-deserved rest in the holy atmosphere of Kedarnath.



Day 10: A Divine Morning at the Feet of Kedarnath

Your day begins early with the option to attend the powerful Rudra Abhishek at 3:00 AM (optional), followed by a peaceful general Darshan of the Kedarnath Shivling. After seeking blessings, we visit the Adi Shankaracharya Samadhi, the sacred Retas Kund, and the Bhairav Temple—the residence of the guardian deity of the Himalayas. Since we start early to avoid the crowds, we skip breakfast and begin our descent back to Sonprayag via the scenic mountain trail. By evening, you will reach Sonprayag to enjoy a warm, comforting dinner and a relaxing overnight stay, carrying with you the divine energy of the Dham.

After an early breakfast, we depart for Badrinath, the crown jewel of the Char Dham Yatra. Upon arrival and check-in, you'll visit the iconic Badrinath Temple on the banks of the Alaknanda River to seek blessings. The highlight of your day will be the powerful Evening Aarti, a truly divine experience that glows under the Himalayan stars. 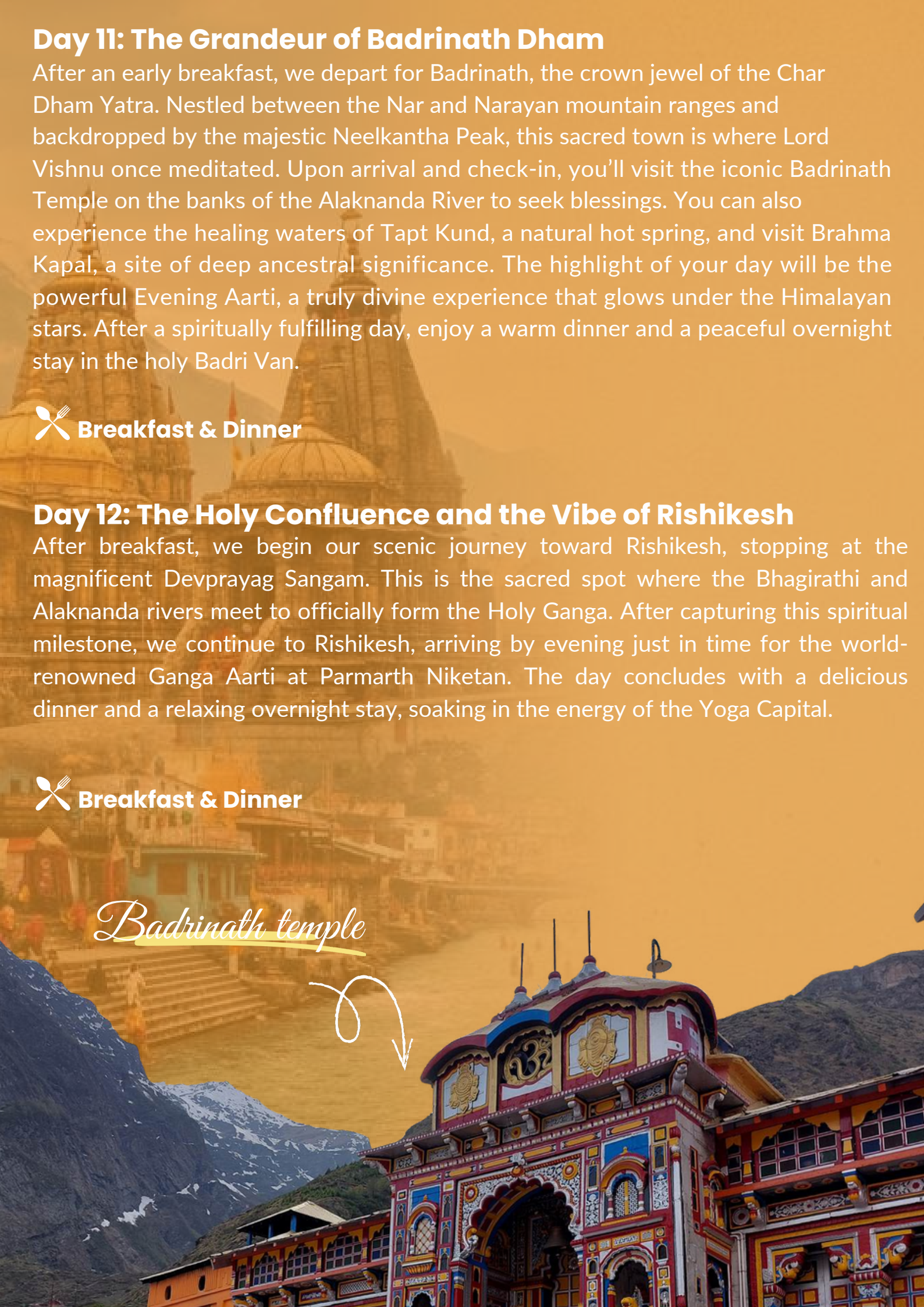
Day 12: The Holy Confluence and the Vibe of Rishikesh
